

Child Safety Policy

The 247 dentist is committed to creating and maintaining a safe environment for young children. For the purpose of this policy a young child is defined as somebody who their parent or carer considers is too young to visit the dental practice on their own. This practice recognises the complexity of laws regulating child minding and has created this policy because team members do not have the training or insurance to look after other people's children.

Whilst on the premises young children must be accompanied by a parent or carer at all times. Team members are unable to accept the responsibility for looking after young children whilst their parent or carer is having emergency dental treatment.

The company policy is to allow a chaperone, if necessary, to accompany a patient. If patient attends with a child, the staff will ask the parent or carer to take the child into the treatment room with them.

If the parent or carer is unable to co-operate, the staff will consult with the Clinical Manager.

This policy operates together with the Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy (M 233-CVP).
